

FACTS	WHAT DOES HOCKING VALLEY BANK DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: • Social Security number and income • Account balances and payment history • Credit history and credit scores
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons HOCKING VALLEY BANK chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness Affiliates from using your information to market to you Sharing for non-affiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.		
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Each joint consumer may opt out separately. One joint consumer may opt out on behalf of all the joint consumers.		

Definitions		
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Hocking Valley Bank has one affiliate, Net Enterprises, Inc. We do not share information with the company.	
Non-affiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. • Elan Financial Services	
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. • Elan Financial Services
